**Parish Property Bookings:** To comply with new requirements as established by the Diocesan Property Commission, anyone or any group wishing to renew or book the use of parish property ie Old School, Kilbride Hall, will be requested to complete an application form and present a copy of their Insurance policy. Primary Schools will be done through the Boards of Management . If the activity will involve children, they must have a Safeguarding Children Policy in place and must sign documentation to that effect. Bookings should be made through the parish office at (01) 8255342 at least three weeks in advance of commencement of activities. Old School will be available on Sundays only after 12.15 pm and Kilbride Hall will not be available on Sundays until 11.00 am.
