St Peter

Is the rock of faith that the Church is built upon (cf. Matthew 16:18). His call, from Jesus, is that of the principal of unity for us, to be the shadow of Christ in time (cf. Acts 5:15) and binder of souls for God (cf. Matthew 19:16). Peter stands for Jesus and he still speaks in Pope Leo today who succeeds him as our Father in the faith. Peter's call speaks to every vocation. It asks us to love Jesus, to follow Him and to be Him for others.

St Paul

Is depicted with a sword. He tells us, imprisoned and about to die for Christ, "I have fought the good fight" (2 Timothy 4:7). He gave all he had for the Lord. He spoke, he taught and he lived the example of an Apostle with humility and integrity. His going out to the world is wedded to Peter's love for Christ. Paul's vocation tells every man considering a call to the Sacred Priesthood, that they must be as the Apostle; to be men who will fight for Jesus, who live authentic lives and with humility, so that the Word of God shines from their calling.
