Croagh Patrick - Reek Sunday – 28 July:

Reek Sunday falls on 28 July, when thousands of pilgrims are expected to scale Croagh Patrick (2,510ft/765m), Ireland's Holy Mountain, to pray and participate on the summit in the Sacraments of Reconciliation (Confession), and of the Eucharist. Pope Francis has designated 2024 as a Year of Prayer, and this year's pilgrimage theme is: 'To pray for and honour grandparents and the elderly' #ElderlyandGrandparents.

How to be a missionary synodal Church

The General Secretariat of the Synod of Bishops has published the working document (known as the *Instrumentum Laboris*) for the second session of the Universal Synod that will be held in Rome in October. This document is the fruit of consultation and discernment that took place across the world earlier this year. The consultation that took place in the Diocese of Meath formed part of the submission of the Irish Episcopal Conference.
